Item 122.3 Taxi consultation- LB concerned at proposals for large permanent badge signage and CCTV impact on private hire firms in rural areas. Access to provide for vulnerable/elderly for rural support transport service as part of private hire businesses will be curtailed/ended by new proposed policy. Council are to discuss the implications further restriction of rural transport services /resolve under item 122.3. SK advised panther Services moved out of City due to regulation changes- likely to move back if SCDC agree proposed changes(revenue loss to SCDC)

Option now looking at autonomous metro (tunnelled)- A428 plans- Park and Ride at Scotland Farm, large potential impacts on Coton and Hardwick villages. Tunnel costs approx. £2bn. All development contributions likely to be taken for this project-nothing left for the villages. Proposal of land tax payments of £40k per new property is proposed to pay for it– greenbelt threat. Anglia TV- will be here on Thursday 6-6.30pm- local choirs-live transmission 6-6.30pmwill concentrate on loneliness and isolation. WI hall application has been submitted. Cllr Kindersley (District and County representative)-Ram raid on Co-Op Saturday night-after the ATM-it is a highly valued local facility. SK concerned about condition of pavements after heavy snow. /extreme weather conditions-suggested Parish Council consider a good neighbour scheme. SK comparing at Alzheimers Charity carol concert at St Johnsplease come along. AG and AF have been out as volunteers and gritted all major pathways to access shops/co-op. Thanks to them for their hard work. Need more saltclerks to request some more. BS Guides are doing gifts for the elderly with Baptist minister-BS to contact the warden. BS and SK left the meeting.
